



SPOTTERS' DAY – GENERAL INFORMATION

TIME

Spotters' Day starts at **08:00** and ends at **17:00**.

Participation is free of charge. However, you must register in advance and receive a confirmation email from us containing your personal participant number. Food and beverages can either be purchased (see link below) or brought with you.

Meeting Point and Access

To gain access to Spotters' Day, you must report to **Gate 8** on **Gammel Thistedvej**, located in the western part of the air base. The nearest civilian address is:

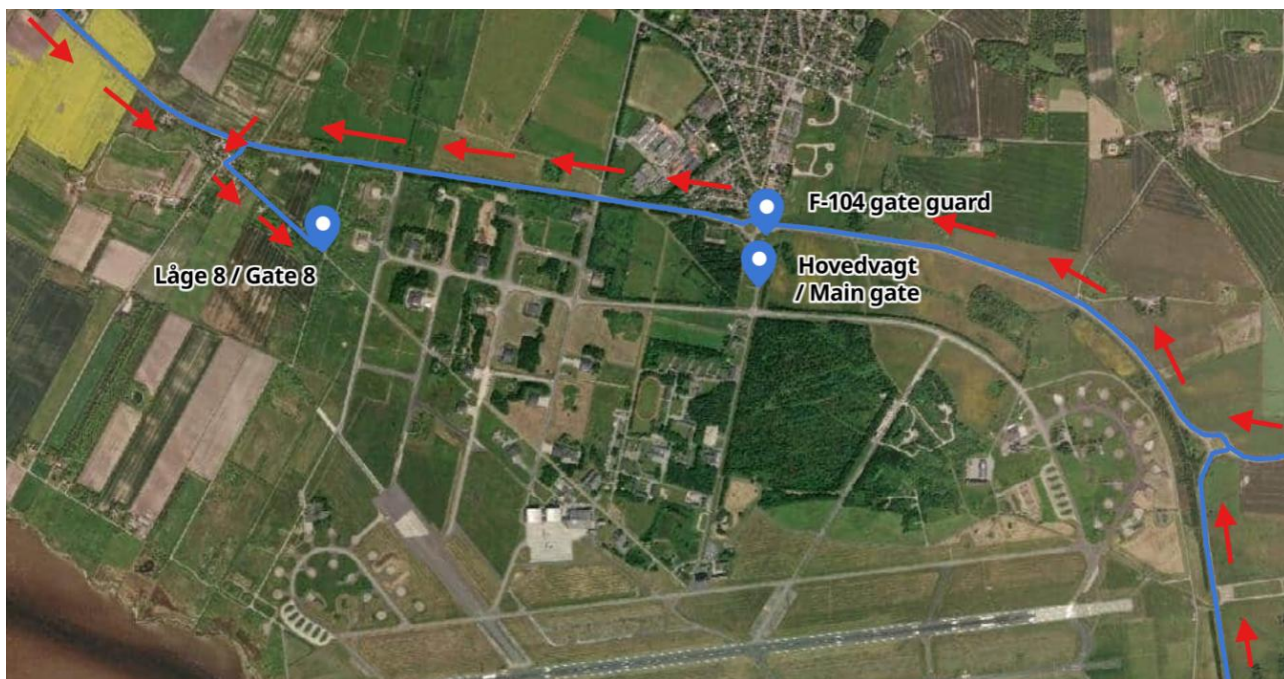
Our staff will welcome you upon arrival.

If you are travelling via **Route 11/55 (Thisted Landevej)**, turn onto **Vejlen** towards **Gjøl**. After approximately **100 metres**, turn left onto **Gammel Thistedvej**. **Gate 8** is located at the end of the road.

Please note that **access to Spotters' Day is only possible via Gate 8**. Entry through the air base's main gate or any other access point is **not permitted**.

Arrival Time

Gate 8 will open at 08:00 and close again at 09:00.

If you arrive after 09:00, you will unfortunately not be granted access to the event.

Identification

You have received an email from us confirming your participation in Spotters' Day.

The subject line contains your three-digit participant number, followed by your name.

Upon arrival at Gate 8, you must present either a printed or digital copy of the confirmation email together with valid identification:

- **Danish citizens: Passport, driver's licence, or military ID card.**
- **Foreign nationals: Passport.**

Parking and Registration

After entering the military area through Gate 8, you will be directed to a parking area near the Static Display. From there, proceed to the registration area.

During your stay at the air base, we will temporarily hold your passport or driver's licence for security purposes. In return, you will be issued a temporary ID card.

Your passport or driver's licence will, of course, be returned to you when you leave the air base.

Temporary ID Card

Your temporary ID card must be worn clearly visible at all times during the event.



If you lose your ID card, you must notify the organisers immediately by calling (+45) 9133 5793.

Static Display Area and Photography Area South of the Runway

During the day, you may stay in either of the following locations:

- **The Static Display Area**, located north of the runway.
- **The Photography Area**, located south of the runway.

A shuttle bus operates between the two areas throughout the day. If you wish to move from one area to the other, you must use the shuttle bus.

The first shuttle bus departs from the **Static Display Area** at **09:30**. Thereafter, buses run approximately every **20 minutes** until **16:00**.

Staying in Aircraft Operating Areas

If you are located in an area where aircraft are taxiing or being towed, you must immediately move far enough away to allow the aircraft to pass without obstruction.



It is strictly prohibited to attempt to stop an aircraft.

Security

All participants must be prepared to undergo random security checks of themselves and/or their luggage in order to detect prohibited items such as firearms, knives, explosives, and similar items.

The checks will be carried out by the Military Police or trained security personnel.

Career Day for Conscripts

A Career Day for Conscripts will take place at the same time as Spotters' Day.

This means that approximately 2,000 conscripts will have access to the Static Display Area from 10:30 to 16:00.

We therefore recommend that you photograph the aircraft in the Static Display Area before the conscripts arrive.

You are of course welcome to remain in the area together with the conscripts, but please be aware that there will be many people around the aircraft.

FAQ – Frequently Asked Questions

Will there be barriers around the aircraft?

Yes. Most aircraft will be cordoned off with cones, ropes, or barriers.

It is not permitted to move or remove any type of barrier. It is also not permitted to climb over or otherwise bypass barriers.

If an aircraft is not cordoned off, you **must not approach the aircraft**. You must remain at a distance of **five metres** from the aircraft.

It is also not permitted to remove or move any protective covers or covers fitted to the aircraft.

What about food and beverages?

You have two options:

- **Bring your own food.**
- **Pre-order a meal from Smuk Event, which provides catering during Danish Air Show.**

Pre-ordered meals are served exclusively in the dining tent.

It is not possible to purchase food in the Photography Area south of the runway.

Free drinking water will be available in the Photography Area.



Procedure for Ordering Food from Smuk Event

Ordering and payment of food is an arrangement between you, as the customer, and **Smuk Event**, as the supplier. The organisers of Spotters' Day have no influence on prices or any other customer/supplier matters. You can pre-order and pay for food by following this link:

Will other food stands be open at the venue?

No. On **Saturday 12 September**, only the dining tent will serve food.

All other food and beverage outlets will be closed.

If you wish to purchase food, you must therefore pre-order from **Smuk Event**.

What bags and equipment am I allowed to bring?

You may bring:

- **Bag(s) for camera equipment.**
- **One smaller bag or backpack for personal belongings as well as food and beverages.**
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The following items are **not permitted**:

- Ladders
- Folding chairs
- Pull carts/trolleys
- Tents
- Parasols
- Coolers or similar items
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What happens if I cannot provide valid identification?

If you cannot present valid identification upon arrival, you will unfortunately not be granted access to Spotters' Day.

May I bring a friend who is not registered?

No. Only persons who have received a personal email containing a participant number will be granted access. All others will be denied entry.

Can I buy merchandise?

Generally, no.

There will be no official merchandise sales on Saturday.

However, individual exhibitors may sell items from their own stands.



Where are the toilets located?

Toilets will be available in the **Static Display Area** as well as in the **Photography Area south of the runway**.

May I bring a drone?

No. Drones are **strictly prohibited**.

Any use of a drone will be reported to the police.

What should I do if I wish to leave Spotters' Day before 16:00?

Send an email to atw-721-c311@mil.dk stating your participant number and the time at which you wish to leave Spotters' Day.

We will then contact you to coordinate the details.

If you have not arranged an earlier departure in advance, it will only be possible to leave the event from **16:00**.

Will I receive a programme for the day?

Yes. Upon arrival, you will receive a detailed programme for Spotters' Day.

We aim to provide participants with as many opportunities as possible, and therefore the final programme will only be confirmed a few days before the event.

We recommend that you read the programme carefully before arriving at Spotters' Day.

Where can I find the flight schedule for the day?

Together with the Spotters' Day programme, you will also receive an overview of the planned flights for the day.

What should I do if I see or hear something suspicious during the event?

Immediately contact the nearest military representative if you see or hear anything that you consider suspicious.

You may also contact the air base control centre by telephone:

Upon arrival, you will receive a list of the most important telephone numbers.

How do I take the bus to the Photography Area?

Go to the registration area where you registered upon arrival.

One or more shuttle buses will be waiting here.

You must use a bus with the sign **"SPOTTER"** displayed in the front window.



The buses operate between the north and south sides of the runway approximately every **20 minutes**.

The first bus departs from the north side at **09:30**.
